Main intake is September, with options for mid year starts – January / April subject to numbers

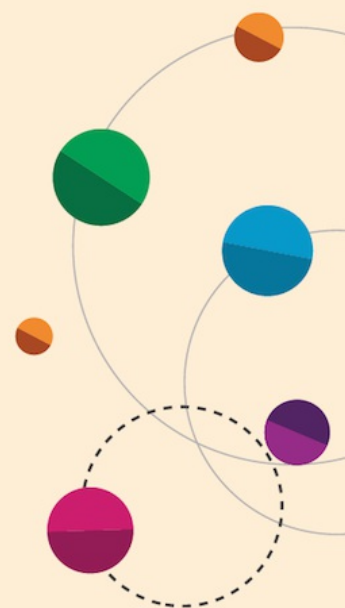
An Engineering Technician apprentice could learn skills such as:
