Skills Test and Oral Questioning (Hairdressing)

The assessment by an independent assessor will require the apprentice to work on a minimum of two models. The apprentice is responsible for providing suitable models for the end-point assessment, and the employer or training provider should support where necessary.

The models can be familiar to the apprentice.

The end-point assessment will take a maximum of six hours excluding breaks.

The learner must shampoo and condition hair as part of at least one service of the end assessment, this maybe more as appropriate.
