

Apprenticeship Standard: Level 3 Motor Vehicle Service and Maintenance Technician (Light Vehicle)



Practical Period

Typical duration to Gateway 36 months (without RPL)



Day Release at Stoke on Trent College:

Off job hours – minimum of **466 hours**, to be completed during usual working hours (OJH calculation based on 40 hours contract and full practical period duration)
